REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

PRESENTATION CRITERIA

We encourage sessions that demonstrate effectiveness as related to an identified need. To be considered for inclusion in the conference, proposals for Breakout Sessions should relate to the theme of “Framework for the Future” and one or more of the following:

- Student Learning and Well-Being
- Policy/Advocacy/Communications
- School or District Leadership
- Human Resources/Finance/School Business

The session should help equip school and district leaders with proven strategies that can positively impact students, personnel, and/or the community. Information presented should be timely and data based.

PROCESS FOR SUBMITTING A BREAKOUT SESSION PROPOSAL
